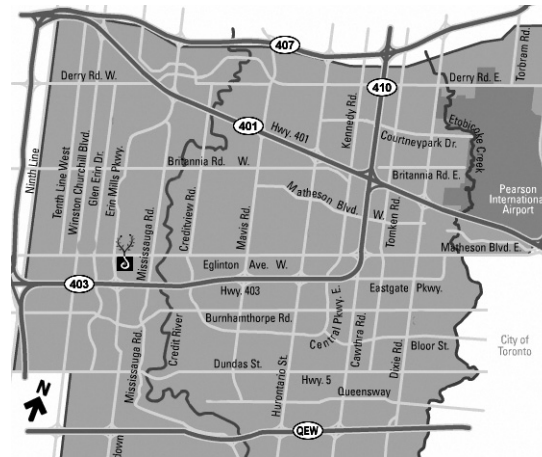

The nurses, paediatricians and staff work closely with The Hospital for Sick Children to provide the patient's treatment schedule.

The nurse will book follow-up appointments, link community services as needed and provide health teaching to the patient and his/her family when required.

The Credit Valley Hospital and The Hospital for Sick Children have formed a partnership to care for children with cancer in their own community.

When the patient is referred to our clinic by The Hospital for Sick Children, they will send a history and treatment plan to The Credit Valley Hospital. While the child is at Credit Valley, we will communicate with the primary nurse and oncologist to keep them informed of the child's progress and treatments.

Welcome to The Credit Valley Hospital Paediatric Oncology Services

The clinic is located in the paediatric department on the first floor (1C).

Registered nurses, pediatricians and other hospital staff work together to care for the patients.

What Services do we Provide?

The clinic offers a variety of services including:

- Chemotherapy
- Blood specimen collection
- Blood and blood product transfusion
- Central line/port-a-cath care
- X-ray and ultrasound tests
- Vital sign monitoring
- Human immune globulin and factor transfusions
- Medication administration ie. V-Zig

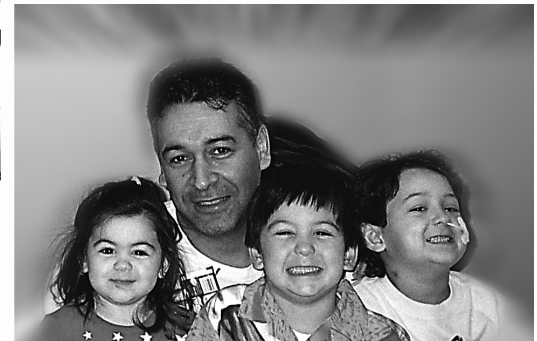


In-Patient Ward Services

If a child requires hospitalization, we will admit the child to our paediatric unit and work closely with The Hospital for Sick Children to provide care for the child and family.



Children are sometimes admitted to Credit Valley for fever neutropenia, dehydration from nausea and vomiting or for IV therapy.



Fever Neutropenia?

A private room will be assigned to children admitted with neutropenia. Special precautions will be used to protect the child. The nursing staff is well-educated in neutropenia-care and take the patient's needs into consideration with staffing assignments. Parents may visit 24 hours a day. Parents are welcome to stay with the child. We encourage the parents' participation in the child's care and welcome any suggestions to help make the child's stay a pleasant one.
